Candidate must have a bachelor's degree and 3 or more years experience in youth programming in one or more of the following: leadership development, advocacy, enrichment, recreational programs, or social services, in a community-based setting.

Candidates should have strong leadership and organizational skills, and bring a passion and vision that builds upon the current quality and wide range of youth and teen programs offered by MyCom.
