### Application Process

A committee made up of NLC graduates and Institute staff will review all complete applications and then interview applicants. Candidates will be selected based on their application, recommendation letters, interviews, and such criteria as demonstrated neighborhood involvement, willingness to learn, diversity, and commitment to the program.

**The deadline to apply is November 16, 2018.**

### Cost of Participation

Each participant is responsible for a \$150 program fee, payable in three installments if desired. The full cost of the class is \$2,500 per participant, which includes cost of materials, meals, retreat, bus tour, and program staff. This cost is covered through grants and fundraising.
